

As believers we must live faith driven lives! This is the main thing that keeps us continuing to do and living what we are supposed to as disciples of the Lord. Without the faith we cease to be followers of the Lord, we don't want to get involved in this kind of community, we don't care, we don't have the sense of concern at all. That's why the apostles approached the Lord to increase their faith. They feel inadequate of it. And Jesus had to tell them what faith can possibly do should they have it. "If you have the faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, be uprooted and planted in the sea, and it would obey you."

This enables them to fulfill even beyond what they can normally do. Faith makes them fulfill what God wills for them to people and not based or according to what they want. Faith propels them to do the things of God - anything that concerns for the good of every one. Their concern for the people's welfare becomes limitless. In this way the seed of faith among them grows just like any seed whenever nourished, it grows. That's faith, it needs to be nurtured. To do this we need each other and come to Jesus who shows us always the way for us to grow as a community doing God's will - our care for all, our mercy and generosity becomes unlimited, unbounded - we go beyond of what is obliged from us. It is who we are - this is our identity as followers and as children of God!


