As we end the Liturgical year this Thoughts week, we are proclaiming the Lord from Fr. Rod Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. His kingship differs from the worldly kings.

His throne is the cross where he was crucified and died. His kingship is servanthood as he said "I came to serve and not to be served." This life of service is what he inculcated to his disciples. He even "dramatized" this during the last supper as he washed the feet of all his disciples. He demonstrated to them how they must humble themselves so that they could live the life of service. He instructed them also the necessity of loving one another so that they would be known as his followers. He said "You will be known that you are my disciples as you love one another."

Let us continue to proclaim our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe through the kind of life we live as his followers.



Second Collection this Week Diocesan Poverty Relief Fund and Catholic Relief Services

The Catholic Relief Services Collection is an opportunity for you to help improve the lives of the most vulnerable people around the world and here in the United States. Your support funds organizations dedicated to aiding people affected by war and natural disasters, migrants and refugees in need of material and legal assistance, and people worldwide whose livelihoods are impacted by changing political and environmental conditions.
