

This weekend begins another liturgical year of the Church. As the Season of Advent starts, we begin another calendar year of the Church, technically, it's the new year of the Church. It is another year of moving forward in our journey with the Lord. As believers, we are disciples of the Lord, Jesus Christ. Here, we are called to show what we learned from the master in the life we live courageously until he comes again in his glory. Rest assured of his promise "Don't be afraid I will be with you until the end of time," (Matthew 28: 20). Our life style must point out what we profess in the Lord. It is imperative of Christian faith to always proclaim our belief over and above anything else in the world until he comes again.

As we start this new liturgical year let us be reminded, as believers, of God's will. And as we wait in joyful hope his second coming, let our lives be geared towards it. So, this Advent Season helps us focus on our preparations for Jesus' coming. But it's good to be aware of the two phases of his coming. His 1st coming happened when it was announced by the angel to the Blessed Mother, when God's Word was made flesh, God's incarnation. This is the focus of the celebration of the Season of Advent which has four weeks duration which ushers us to the celebration of Christmas, the birth of the Lord, Jesus Christ our savior; and the whole season of Christmas until the Lord's Baptism. As we celebrate his birth, we also look forward to His return in glory, his 2nd and final coming where all the angels, and saints join together with the rest of the faithful (1 Thessalonians 4: 16-17).

So as we journey in between these two phases of the Lord's coming, the interim time, we continue to live up to God's will hoping that on the last day we will join all the angels and saints in God's eternity.






