





Bishop Kulick to speak at Saint Vincent on January 21; Father John-Mary Tompkins to speak on *Lectio Divina*

The Most Reverend Larry J. Kulick, JCL, will address Oblates of Saint Benedict, their guests, and the general public on Sunday, January 21, at 7:00 P.M. in the Parish Assembly Room at Saint Vincent Archabbey. He will speak on the topic "The Call to Intentional Discipleship." All those who are interested are welcome to attend.

Also, a series of monthly presentations on Benedictine spirituality will continue on Sunday, January 21, from 3:00 P.M. to 4:15 P.M. in seminary classroom Brownfield Room 202. The topic will be "Lectio divina" (holy reading)," and Father John-Mary Tompkins, O.S.B., Vice-Rector of Saint Vincent Seminary, will be the presenter. To appreciate the presentation one does not need to have

attended previous sessions. The sessions will probably also be offered on Zoom. Attendees may also attend Vespers at 5:00 P.M. in the Archabbey Basilica.

WHAT CATHOLICS DO, AND WHY?

A New Series, by Dr. Eugene M. Dangelo Part 3: What is "Ordinary Time?"

Ordinary Time is the modern name given to a set of 33 or 34 weeks of the Church year which occur in two courses. The first course of Ordinary Time occurs between the end of the Christmas Season right after the Baptism of the Lord, and the beginning of the Lenten Season with Ash Wednesday. Before the 1969 revision of the Church Calendar, those Sundays were referred to as Sundays after Epiphany, except for the three Sundays immediately before Ash Wednesday, which were called, respectively, Septuagesima Sunday, Sexagesima Sunday, and Quinquagesima Sunday. All of these are now Sundays in Ordinary Time. The Second (and longer) course of Ordinary Time begins right after Pentecost with Trinity Sunday, and ends with the Feast of Christ the King, which ends the Church Year. Previously, these Sundays were simply called Sundays after Pentecost. The liturgical color assigned to Ordinary Time is green. Whether there are 33 or 34 weeks in Ordinary time is determined by the date of Easter for any particular year. Unlike the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, Ordinary Time does not focus on a particular aspect of the Christian Mystery, but rather is a time for general meditation on Christ's ongoing message to all!
