


Altar Servers Needed

What Catholics Do, And Why? A Series by Dr. Eugene M. Dangelo Part 7: The Seven Sacraments

Some of us still remember the old Baltimore Catechism of the Catholic Church, which defined a Sacrament as "An outward sign, instituted by Christ, to give Grace." That definition is still accurate today, and sometimes people wonder at which actual points each sacrament was instituted by Christ. The seven sacraments practiced by the Church today are: Baptism, Holy Eucharist, Reconciliation (also known as Penance), Confirmation, Matrimony, Holy Orders, and Anointing of the Sick (formerly known as Extreme Unction). These sacraments are classified in three categories: Sacraments of Initiation, which include Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist, Sacraments of Healing, which include Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick, and Sacraments of Service, which include Matrimony and Holy Orders. Of these, Jesus instituted Baptism at His Ascension, when He told the Apostles to go out into the world, baptizing all in the name of the Trinity. Holy Eucharist was instituted at the Last Supper, and Confirmation was instituted when Jesus sent the Holy Spirit as tongues of flame upon the Apostles at the first Pentecost. Ordination (Holy Orders) was instituted partly at the Last Supper, with the granting of the power to Consecrate, and partly on the evening after the Resurrection, with the granting of power to the Apostles to forgive and retain sins. St. James recorded Christ's instructions for absolution in Penance and also for Extreme Unction. Matrimony became a sacrament when Christ declared Marriage to be indissoluble, ending the dispensation given by Moses. Thus, our seven sacraments truly come from Jesus Christ, Himself!
