

WHAT CATHOLICS DO, AND WHY? A Series by Dr. Eugene M. Dangelo Part 8: Commandments and Precepts

Every baptized Catholic has at some point learned the Ten Commandments given to Moses by God Himself, but many Catholics are not as familiar with the Five Precepts of the Catholic Church, which express specific duties of Catholics.

The Ten Commandments are:

1. I am the Lord your God: you shall not have strange gods before me. 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain. 3. Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day. 4. Honor your Father and your Mother. 5. You shall not kill. 6. You shall not commit adultery. 7. You shall not steal. 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. 9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife. 10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

The Five Precepts of the Catholic Church are:

- 1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and rest from servile labor.
- 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
- 3. You shall receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.
- 4. You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- 5. You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.

The precepts of the Church themselves go hand in hand with the observance of the Ten Commandments in order to enhance the spiritual lives of all Catholics.
